RA Stamp Club Return to Play Protocol

Overview: The Return to Play (RTP) document was jointly developed by the RA Stamp Club (RASC) and the RA Centre management team to support a normalization of club operations during the period where public health authorities are concerned about the transmission of the COVID-19 virus.

This document describes the measures that the RA Centre and the RASC will implement to address situations where club members participate in activities at the RA Centre. All provincial and local health authority restrictions as well as RA Centre policies and guidelines must be adhered to.

The primary approach of the RASC to ensure participant safety will continue to be the use of internet-based technology for meetings whenever possible and minimizing in-person contact as much as possible.

Background: The Executive Committee of the RASC and RA Management have worked in partnership to develop these protocols to reduce the risks and incorporate new ways of operating in situations where internet-based meetings are not possible.

The RASC Executive Committee and RA management team is committed to modifying this document as new information or updated guidance is provided.

Safety Measures:

At this time it has been decided by RASC Executives that the RA Stamp Club will remain active but will forgo in person meetings. The Club will continue to run regular Monday evening meetings through the platform "Zoom".

During the creation of this document, Ottawa is in Orange "Restrict" zone of the Covid -19 Response framework document which does allow in person meetings to take place. The RASC Executive Committee and RA Management are in constant contact and this document will be updated in the event the Committee decides to change to in person meetings.

Once the Stamp Executive Committee in partnership with RA Management, decides to return to regular in person meetings The Return to Play document will be updated. The update will include protocols to ensure our members, staff and volunteers remain safe and contribute to stop the spread of Covid-19. At this time there will also be a requirement for members to signing an Acknowledgement, Assumption of Risks, Waiver and Release of Claims – Coronavirus (COVID-19).
