GAME INTERRUPTION AND CANCELLATION PROTOCOL

GAME INTERRUPTION

This protocol must be followed if a game is interrupted due to unforeseen events such as an injury, a fire alarm, facility issues (power failure, ice conditions) etc.

GAMES THAT HAVE COMPLETED AT LEAST 5 ENDS:

The score is to be recorded as final. Ends not played will be divided between the teams and added to those already won during the game.

IN GAMES THAT ARE INTERRUPTED BEFORE 5 ENDS ARE COMPLETED

The score is to be recorded as tied, one point per team. Ends not played will be divided between the teams and added to those already won during the game.

GAME CANCELLATION

In rare cases where, due to an unforeseen event such as extreme weather conditions or when the RA is closed (e.g., due to a power outage or other facility issues), the Women's Daytime Section chairperson, in consultation with the Match & Rules Committee chairperson, will cancel all scheduled games in that draw in that timeslot.

- All cancelled games will be recorded as follow:
 - 0 SCORE; 0 ENDS; and 0 POINTS
