TROPHY PROTOCOL

Astrid Kempster and Centennial Draws

RACC Women's Daytime section currently has two Draws where trophies are awarded: Astrid Kempster (generally, held in the November/December timeframe) and Centennial (generally, held in the March/April timeframe).

PROTOCOL

All teams participating in the respective draw (Tuesday morning, Wednesday afternoon, and Thursday morning sessions) are eligible to win a trophy. Following the last game of the draw, the Score Master for each session will calculate the points for each team, as per normal procedure, and notify the Match & Rules Committee Chairperson.

The Match & Rules Committee Chairperson will determine which team has the highest points at the end of the draw and notify the skips of the winning teams if their team will be an award recipient.

Trophy will be awarded to the team with the most cumulative points for the session (see *Scorekeeping Protocol*). Standard WDDL tie breaker protocol applies (cumulative ends won then cumulative point differential)

TROPHIES

The winner of the Astrid Kempster draw will receive the Astrid Kempster Trophy.

The winner of the Centennial Draw will receive the Centennial Trophy. The runners up will receive the Suzanne Tremblay Trophy.
